Review & Approve Meeting Notes:

Review Parking & Commuter Services Business Plan:

The group reviewed the Parking Inventory, Schedule of Fines, JackPass Ridership, and Parking Rates. There was a question as to why JackPass ridership drops in March. Traci said that she will try to get more detailed data from the transit systems so we can better understand what weeks have lower ridership. It was also brought up that the published Parking Rates may be incorrect. Traci will follow up with the Cashiers Office to get clarification on this.

The group reviewed the SWOT Analysis section of the Business Plan and made the following comments/suggestions:

Weakness

- No available land to expand on
- Roots in parking lots
- Many small parking lots
- Not enough bike racks. Students would like higher security for bikes
- Not optimizing schedules in consideration of peak demands for parking

Opportunity

- Off campus parking/partnerships
- Improvements in alternative Transportation opportunities

Strength

- Large percentage of students are residents or live within two miles of campus

- Sustainably conscious student body

Reword #2 under threats – there is only one choice for alternate Transportation. There are limited options for public or commercial transit

Reword “sense of entitlement” under weakness & threat sections.

Review Parking & Commuter Services 5-Year Budget Plan:

Traci reported that she is still waiting on feedback from the Budget Office on the 5-Year Budget Plan

The group discussed the Capital Outlay Plan, Deferred Maintenance Projects, Capital Renewal Projects and Major capital Projects. Traci said that the projects that we need to focus on are Electrical Vehicle Charging Stations, and taking care of what we have. She will be researching the possibility of an off-site rental lot
